February 13, 2017 Quorum Court Meeting

12 Justices of the Peace Present, Justice Max Render was absent

Judge Ed Hill called the meeting to order at 5:30pm.

Judge Hill stated that the next Quorum Court meeting will occur in Lake City on 2/27/17 at 5:30pm at the courthouse there.

Judge Hill stated that there was progress made with the Lake City Courthouse Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) and asked if there were any questions. As a number of affected elected officials had not received the MOU until close of business the day of the meeting, discussion is slated to occur in outside meetings after adequate time is allowed to understand this issues at hand.

Judge Hill opened the meeting up for questions from the public and two questions were poised by Linda Reed concerning if Animal Control exists to residence in the county and if online county records exist to access information online from each office. As it pertained to Animal Control, Judge Hill informed that no such services exist; however, concerning online records he deferred to the other County officials. Assessor Hannah Towell and Circuit Clerk Candace Edwards spoke to the fact that some records are available online but there may be a cost associated with accessing those records.

With no further business to be discussed Justice Terry Couch motioned to adjourn the meeting into committees with a second from Justice David Tennison, all were in favor and the meeting stood adjourned at 5:35pm.
