Assessment Computation: Determined initially by local appointees, or by private contractors, at time of formation; approved by the Board; submitted to the County Court for approval after notice of hearing published. A flat tax, if used, as permitted by State law, does not require an assessment, only Board approval and submission to the County Court after notice of hearing.
