May 11, 2015 Quorum Court Meeting

11 Justices of the Peace Present, Justice Jim Bryant and Josh Longmire were absent.

Judge Ed Hill called the meeting to order at 5:30pm.

Judge Ed Hill ordered Appropriation Ordinance 2015-3 read dealing primarily with the reallocation of funds to be spent for upgrades to increase weapons of mass destruction preparedness of first responders. Upon reading of the ordinance Justice Fred Bowers motioned for the adoption of the ordinance seconded by Justice Barbara Weinstock. The motion passed 11-0. – *Appendix 1*

Tony discussed an upcoming ordinance for passage in the next meeting dealing with establishing guidelines; as well as, a policies and procedures manual for the grant process to formalize the process from where it stands currently. This will make Craighead more competitive for various grants.

John Reeves questioned donations that were mentioned in the paper that were given from the county tax payer dollars and asked for some explanation of this. Judge Ed Hill and Assistant to the Judge Tony Thomas discussed it was not truly donations but contractual obligations for services provided to the people of Craighead County. Additional light discussion of the issue ensued.

Road Superintendent Eugene Neff distributed the monthly road report. – *Appendix 2*

With no further business to be discussed Justice Richard Rogers motioned to adjourn the meeting with a second from Justice David Tennison, all were in favor and the meeting stood adjourned at 5:45pm.

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 2015-3

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF CRAIGHEAD COUNTY, ARKANSAS; AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

An Ordinance amending the 2015 Annual Operating Budget to add Fund 3570, Dept 500, ADEM Homeland Security FY14 Grant Fund (SHSGP) to be administrated through the Arkansas Department of Emergency Management (ADEM) for the Department of Homeland Security Federal Emergency Management Agency to include monies that have become available to Craighead County to enhance terrorism preparedness and response.

SECTION 1. That these monies will be utilized in accordance with the grant guidelines and will be subject to audit procedures and other grant stipulations. Expenditures of these monies will be used to purchase equipment to enhance the Jonesboro Fire Department HazMat Team capability as a Type 1 Team to Craighead and all of Northeast Arkansas by increasing our unknown chemical and weapons of mass destruction (WMD) identification capability.


SECTION 2. That these monies are considered to be special revenue funds and must be expended for equipment and other purposes as specified in this ordinance.


SECTION 3. That this new fund, department, and line categories will be created in the 2015 Annual Operating Budget to allow for accurate accounting of incoming monies and expenditures, and listing increases in projected special revenues as described below.

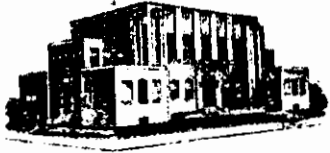


