June 8, 2015 Quorum Court Meeting

13 Justices of the Peace Present

Judge Ed Hill called the meeting to order at 5:30pm.

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Resolution 2015-8 was read to approve an agreement between Craighead County and the Game and Fish Commission regarding the responsibilities of both parties as it pertains to Bono Lake. Jovial discussion ensued about the future of Bono Lake; as well as, some of the various projects that have been floated to include over the course of the future of the project. It was stated that in the current conditions great deals of caution need to be taken by individuals who go to the lake property until further actions can be taken to improve safety per Game and Fish Commission officer present. Justice Stacks moved to approve the resolution, seconded by Justice Weinstock. All voted in favor of the motion and the resolution was passed. – *Appendix 1*

With no further business to be discussed Justice Terry Couch motioned to adjourn the meeting into committee meetings with a second from Justice Steve Cline, all were in favor and the meeting stood adjourned to committees at 5:55pm.

RESOLUTION No. 2015-8

**A RESOLUTION ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE ARKANSAS GAME & FISH COMMISSION FOR THE OPERATION OF LAKE BONO**

**WHEREAS**, it is the express desire of the County and the Arkansas Game & Fish Commission to cooperate for the purpose of enhancing sport fishing and providing public fishing opportunities in Craighead County, Arkansas; and

**WHEREAS**, on February 8, 2001, the Arkansas Game & Fish Commission acquired approximately 276 acres of land in Craighead County, Arkansas, at a cost of \$689,500.00 for the purpose of providing real estate upon which a lake would be constructed that would be open to the public for fishing and other recreation; and

**WHEREAS**, in return for the Arkansas Game & Fish Commission's acquisition of the Lake Bono property, the County replaced four wooden bridges to Hatchie Coon Island within the St. Francis Sunken Lands Wildlife Management Area with four permanent concrete bridges at a cost of \$568,045.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the County has constructed a water control structure and lake bed on the Lake Bono property, costing approximately \$4,882,566.83 for benefit of the public and fish and wildlife conservation; and


**WHEREAS**, the water control gates for the lake were closed on April 14, 2014; and

**WHEREAS**, Since establishing there was no written agreement outlining operational responsibilities for Lake Bono, County Judge Ed Hill has worked with Arkansas Game & Fish personnel to develop such agreement;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF CRAIGHEAD COUNTY, ARKANSAS, THAT:**

**Craighead County will enter into an agreement for the operation of Lake Bono that includes, but are not limited to, the following:**

(1) enter into an agreement for a term not to exceed one (1) year with the Commission for the primary purpose of opening, operating, and maintaining a lake on the Lake Bono property that shall be open to the public for recreational fishing and for the secondary purpose of providing opportunity for watching wildlife and other activities related to fish, wildlife, conservation and conservation education activities; (2) accept conveyance of the property upon the terms and conditions and for the consideration agreed to in a final agreement; and (3) upon conveyance, enter into a Memorandum of Agreement concerning the management of the Lake Bono fishery and site improvements;
