August 10, 2015

12 Justices of the Peace present. Justice Billie Sue Hoggard absent.

Judge Hill called the meeting to order.

Distributed to the Court was the Monthly Road Report – *Appendix 1*.

Distributed to the Court was the Monthly Sheriff's Report – *Appendix 2*.

Justice Ken Stacks began with a review of the Finance Committee meeting. The main focus of discussion concerned the cost of data storage for the county. Justice Stacks explained to the Court that the bidding process for the needed update had taken place on the state level. Justice Josh Longmire requested that another bid take place to ensure the county was receiving the best price. Bidding out and price checking would enable the county to negotiate. Justice Stacks reiterated that the county had already gone through the bidding process and preparing more bids would take more time. Justice Longmire stated to the Court that some of the prices on the price list appeared to be high and another option was needed if only to better educate the Court. Justice Barbara Weinstock and others inquired to the time another bidding process would take. Computer Services Director Erin Johnson said he would work within the timeline given to him by the court. He also stated that he approached the Judge's office with his concerns in January and had only come to the Court when a solution was decided on. Justice Meadows agreed it could not hurt to bid this update out again. Judge Hill suggested sending a fact sheet of the needed materials and devices to different companies to gather a pricing comparison. The timeline of another bid was said to take four weeks with the update after the purchase to take three to four weeks to install. Johnson stated that the system in place today could potentially last another year or fail within a few months and if the purchase was postponed it would become more necessary as time continued. Justice Longmire questioned if this was either a situation of an imminent threat of the system going down in weeks or if they had a year to again bid out the update and obtain more information. With no answer, Justice Stacks motioned to allow Computer Services to proceed with the purchase. With seven in favor, three against, and three abstaining, the motion passed by majority. Assistant to the Judge Tony Thomas assured the Court that they would continually be informed throughout the updating process.

With no further business to be discussed Justice Terry Couch motion to adjourn with meeting with a second from Justice David Tennison.
