November 25, 2019 Quorum Court Minutes

All Justices of the Peace present.

Judge Day called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

The first order of business was the approval of the November 12, 2019 minutes. Justice Weinstock made a motion to approve the minutes and Justice Pasmore seconded.

Committee Minutes: Justice Rogers read the November 12, 2019 Public Service Committee meeting minutes. A copy of same is attached hereto as *Addendum A*.

Justice Longmire read the November 12, 2019 Finance Committee meeting minutes. A copy of same is attached hereto as *Addendum B*.

Justice Cline read the November 12, 2019 Road Committee meeting minutes. A copy of same is attached hereto is as *Addendum C*.

Old Business: None to discuss.

New Business: The first order of new business was an Ordinance to establish additional motor fuel tax fund in 2019. The Deputy Clerk read the Ordinance, a copy of same is attached hereto as *Addendum D*. Judge Day stated creating this sub fund of the county road fund allows us to know where every penny is going. Justice Weinstock made a motion to pass the Ordinance and Justice Cline seconded. The roll was called and the motion unanimously passed.

The second order of new business was an Ordinance amending the county employment policy regarding juror pay. The Deputy Clerk read the Ordinance, a copy of same is attached hereto as *Addendum E*. Judge Day told the Court the emergency clause was added during the special meeting held before the full Court meeting. Justice Cline made a motion to pass the Ordinance and Justice Price seconded. The roll was called and the motion unanimously passed.

The third order of new business was a Resolution to reappoint Curt Hawkins and to appoint Mark Nichols to the Craighead County Public Library Board. The Deputy Clerk read the Resolution, a copy of same is attached hereto as *Addendum F*. Justice Tennison asked if there were limited terms that Board members could serve? Judge Day told the Court that Board members can be reappointed one time to serve two consecutive terms then the Board member must have at least one year between terms before being able to be reappointed to the Board. Justice Rogers made a motion to adopt the Resolution and Justice Percy seconded. The roll was called and the motion to adopt unanimously passed.

The last order of new business was an Appropriation Ordinance regarding the 2020 budget. The Deputy Clerk read the Appropriation Ordinance, a copy of same is attached hereto as *Addendum G*. Justice Cline made a motion to pass and Justice Weinstock seconded. Judge Day

opened the floor for discussion. Justice Cook began the discussion by asking how many new hires are included in the 2020 budget? Judge Day informed the Court that there was an overall reduction in staff, but the budget included a full-time election coordinator position. Judge Day introduced Ms. Jeanette Robertson, Election Commission Chairman, to the Court. Ms. Robertson discussed the need for the full-time position and described the duties of this position. Ms. Robertson also gave figures of how much money she believes the County would save by having a full-time election coordinator and using ES&S (Election System & Software) less. There was much discussion regarding the full-time election coordinator position and after Ms. Robertson answered all the questions the Justices had for her, Judge Day went back to state that there was also a full-time position added to the District Court. Justice Longmire asked about the IT position at the jail. Sheriff Boyd stated that the position was taken out on the new print out and that it removed \$38,573.91 from the budget. Sheriff Boyd also stated that his Deputy numbers are the same. Justice Williams asked why the budget for the Road Department was upped? Judge Day informed the Court he raised the budget half a million dollars for the Road Department because the roads are in terrible condition and right now, we can afford to fix them to keep them from declining so rapidly. Multiple Justices inquired about the miscellaneous line number and what is considered a miscellaneous purchase. Judge Day stated that the Legislative Audit gives certain categories and some things just do not fall into those categories, so the miscellaneous line item is specifically for those purchases. Justice Weinstock then made a motion to give the County employees a 2% raise. Justice Cline seconded the motion. Justice Cook made a motion to amend Justice Weinstock's motion to state that the Justices of Peace would not be included in the 2% raise. Justice Williams seconded. The roll was called and the amendment to the motion passed unanimously. The roll was called again for the original motion of a 2% raise and the motion passed unanimously. Justice Cook made a motion to table the voting on the budget to the next meeting and Justice Pasmore seconded. Roll was called and the motion to table the voting passed with 9 votes in favor of and 4 against. Justices Cline, Couch, Rogers and Weinstock voted no. With the motion to table passing, the original motion to approve was voided and the Appropriation Ordinance will be voted on in the next full Court meeting.

Announcements: Judge Day announced that the 2020 Quorum Court meeting schedule has been made and a hand out was provided to all Justices. A copy of same is attached hereto as *Addendum H*.

Judge Day also announced that there will be a Christmas Open House in the County Judge's Office on December 11, 2019 from 3-5 p.m.

With no more business, Justice Rogers made a motion to adjourn and Justice Cline seconded. Judge Day adjourned the meeting at 6:54 p.m.

Addendum A

Public Service committee

Nov. 12, 2019

Meeting was called to order at 5:58 p.m. by Chairman Justice Richard Rogers. Those in attendance were Justice Price, Justice Noel, and Justice Williams. Also in attendance were Judge Marvin Day, Sheriff Marty Boyd, Human Resource Manager Lacey Rush, and Craighead County Road Department employees Matt Leonard and David Smith.

First order of business was to review the Ordinance to amend the policy of deducting Jury Duty pay from County employees. This Ordinance will come before the committee for approval before the full court at the next meeting. There was continued discussion on the current County employee personnel policies. After receiving more information, the committee decided to continue further discussion at the next committee meeting. Motion was made to adjourn by Justice Noel and seconded by Justice Williams. Meeting adjourned at 6:33 p.m.

Finance Committee Meeting

November 12, 2019

Finance Committee Members present: Chairman Josh Longmire, Justices Barbara Weinstock, Dan Pasmore, Vince Percy and Darrel Cook.

Others present: County Treasurer Terry McNatt, Collector Wes Eddington, County Judge Assistant Lisa Lawrence.

Chairman Longmire called the Finance Committee meeting to order at 5:57 pm.

Collector Wes Eddington presented the tax collections for October 2019. Comparing January through October 2019, tax collections have surpassed \$5.4 million over what was collected in the same period in 2018. Schools receive 85% and County General should receive approximately \$750,000. There will be a reminder in the paper the week of Thanksgiving to those that haven't paid taxes.

Treasurer Terry McNatt read financial reports for the month ending October 2019. County General Fund ended October with a balance of \$2.35 million. Road Fund finished October with \$3.99 million. Capital Fund ended October with \$1.38 million. Craighead County's October portion of the total sales tax was \$336,525.59.

Justice Weinstock moved to adjourn and Justice Cook seconded. The motion passed unanimously, and Chairman Longmire adjourned the meeting at 6:30 pm.

ROAD COMMITTEE MINUTES

November 12, 2019

Craighead County Road Committee was called to order at 5:57 pm by Chairman Steve Cline. Justices present were David Tennison, Terry Couch, and Barry Forrest.

Others present were Judge Marvin Day and Western Division Road Foreman John James.

John James updated the committee on current road projects. The road department finished the overlay on CR 130, laying the first span on bridge and the gravel is holding up well. With no other business, Justice David Tennison made a motion to adjourn and Justice Terry Couch seconded. Meeting was adjourned at 6:05 pm.

Addendum D

ORDINANCE NO _____

Be It Ordained By the Quorum Court of Craighead County, State of Arkansas:

An Ordinance to Establish the Additional Motor Fuel Tax Fund (Act 416 of 2019); and to Declare an Emergency.

Article 1. Affirmation. It comes before this Court that there is a need to establish a fund on the books of the County Treasurer as a sub fund of the County Road Fund {#2000} to track the revenues and expenditures of the wholesale tax on gasoline and diesel as levied by Act 416 of 2019. This Court recognizes and affirms the need for such a fund to properly account for, control, and report expenditures of such in compliance with Act 416 of 2019, Section 6 and codified as § 26-64-104.

Article 2. Establishment of Fund. There is hereby created on the books of the Craighead County Treasurer a fund to be known as the Additional Motor Fuel Tax Fund (Act 416 of 2019) with a fund number of 2003 as assigned by Arkansas Legislative Audit. The Revenue Code for the county highway turnback receipted to this fund is 7002.

Article 3. Operation of the Fund. The Additional Motor Fuel Tax Fund (Act 416 of 2019) is subject to all the normal county budgeting, appropriation and expenditure regulations of Title 14 and Title 27 in Arkansas Code Annotated. The fund is subject to annual reporting and disclosure requirements to be submitted to the Director of the Department of Finance and Administration. The report shall detail the (a) amount of highway revenue turnback revenues received; (b) expenditures made from the highway revenue turnback revenues received; and (c) projects funded using the highway revenue turnback.

Article 4. Emergency Clause. It is found by this Court that since revenues from this source will be received in December it is fundamentally necessary to establish the Additional Motor Fuel Tax Fund (Act 416 of 2019) immediately in order to track the revenue and expenditures in accordance with the precepts of Act 416 of 2019. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the date of passage and approval.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 2014-3 ESTABLISHING PAY PROCEDURES FOR EMPLOYEES THAT ARE CALLED TO SERVE JURY DUTY, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the Public Service Committee, from time to time, has reviewed and updated the Employment Policy for Craighead County Employees, and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Public Service Committee that there is an area in the Personnel Policy that needs to be changed based on Arkansas Code, and

WHEREAS, in order to be compliant with A.C.A. §21-5-104 an amendment must be implemented to update a certain area of the Employment/Personnel Policy for Craighead County.

NOW THEREFORE, be it Ordained by the Quorum Court of Craighead County, State of Arkansas as follows:

Section 1. Section 13 (a) of the Craighead County Employment Policy adopted by Ordinance 2014-3 shall remove the following under the Section *Other Leave Policies*:

Amounts earned by employees on jury duty shall be subtracted from any wages received from the County while absent.

The following language shall be added:

A County employee called to serve on a jury must notify his/her supervisor immediately upon notice so that his/her work schedule can be modified to accommodate jury duty. Full time employees on jury duty shall receive their regular pay and retain all jury fees.

Section 2. Severability. If any provision of this Ordinance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the remaining provisions of the Ordinance which remains effective absent the invalid provision, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

Emergency Clause: This ordinance, being necessary for the protection and preservation of public health and safety; an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in force and shall take effect immediately upon passage of this Ordinance.

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. _____

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF CRAIGHEAD, STATE OF ARKANSAS, AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED; "AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE ANNUAL OPERATING BUDGET FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2020."

SECTION 1. ANNUAL BUDGET ADOPTED BY REFERENCE. THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2020 IDENTIFIED AS **"2020 ANNUAL BUDGET,"** CRAIGHEAD COUNTY, ARKANSAS, DATED _____, 2019 IS HEREBY ADOPTED BY REFERENCE. A COPY OF SAID BUDGET SHALL BE FILED IN THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY CLERK AND SHALL BE AVAILABLE FOR INSPECTION AND COPYING BY ANY PERSON DURING NORMAL OFFICE HOURS.

SECTION 2. NONRESTRICTED EXPENDITURE CATEGORIES. EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY THIS ORDINANCE SHALL NOT BE RESTRICTED TO THE LINE ITEM EXPENDITURE CODES COMPRISING THE FOUR MAJOR CATEGORIES OF EXPENDITURES - PERSONAL SERVICES, SUPPLIES, OTHER SERVICES AND CHARGES, AND CAPITAL OUTLAYS, BUT SHALL BE RESTRICTED TO OFFICE/DEPARTMENTAL EXPENDITURES WITHIN THE ABOVE ENUMERATED FOUR MAJOR CATEGORIES OF EXPENDITURES EXCEPT FOR FUNDS APPROPRIATED FOR PERSONNEL SALARIES AND WAGES AND RELATED EMPLOYEE BENEFITS. PERSONNEL EXPENDITURES SHALL NOT EXCEED THE DOLLAR AMOUNTS, NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES, AND SALARY OR WAGE RATES SPECIFIED IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET OR AN AMENDMENT THERETO.

ORDINANCE

SECTION 3. EXPENDITURE RESTRICTED TO SPECIFIED FUNDS.

NO EXPENDITURE OF APPROPRIATED FUNDS SHALL BE MADE FROM ANY FUND OTHER THAN THE FUND SPECIFIED IN THIS ORDINANCE OR AN AMENDMENT THERETO.

SECTION 4. TRANSFERS. ANY TRANSFER OF MONIES BETWEEN THE VARIOUS FUNDS OF THE COUNTY OR BETWEEN THE FOUR MAJOR CATEGORIES OF EXPENDITURES, PERSONAL SERVICES, SUPPLIES, OTHER SERVICES AND CHARGES, AND CAPITAL OUTLAYS, SHALL BE MADE ONLY WITH PRIOR APPROVAL OF THE CRAIGHEAD COUNTY QUORUM COURT. PROVIDED, HOWEVER, ALL TRANSFERS BUDGETED FOR IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET SHALL BE EXEMPT FROM THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.
