March 11, 2019 Quorum Court Meeting

13 Justices of the Peace Present.

Judge Marvin Day presided and called the meeting to order at 5:30pm.

Minutes for February 25, 2019 were modified as follows:

Motion was made by Justice Steve Cline and unanimously passed by all present modifying the February 25, 2019 Quorum Court Minutes to include the handouts provided to the Justices of the Peace in preparation for the meeting. The Public Service Committee had been provided a packet for review during this meeting. Same is attached hereto as **Addendum 2**. The Road Committee was also provided a packet for review during committee. Same is attached as **Addendum 3**. Lastly, the Finance Committee was provided a packet for review during committee. Same is attached hereto as **Addendum 4**.

Old Business: None to discuss.

New Business: Judge Day announced that Kevin's Heat and Air (Kevin and Reesa Williams) have donated the Heat and Air units and related necessities to the development of the Crisis Stabilization Unit.

Judge Day noted that the 911 Funding Bill (HB 1564) will come up this next week. The meeting packet for all Justices of the Peace contained all contact information for legislators. Justices were encouraged to contact their legislators regarding this bill. Further, HB 1694 which would designate where you can carry a weapon in the county. The Bill, more or less, would remove the authority of the Quorum Court to make this designation. Rather, the state statutes would designate where to carry weapons in a county. Judge Day noted that from now on he would forward emails received from the AAC regarding upcoming bills to the Justices of the Peace to keep them abreast of upcoming topics that would influence Craighead County.

Lastly, Judge Day announced that a Drug Court Graduation is planned for the following evening at 5:30 p.m. at the District Court Building located at 410 W. Washington, Jonesboro. After a brief discussion regarding Drug Court, Motion was made to adjourn to Committee meetings by Justice Richard Rodgers and was seconded by David Tennison. Motion passed unanimously.
